September Devos and Lessons

Wednesday Night Devo Theme

Devos are typically about 10-15 minutes long, followed up a 20-minute small group time. This month's theme is "Real Friends" and we'll be discussing topics such as: being the friend you want to have, guarding your inner circle, and being kind to others.

Sunday School Lesson Overview

Sunday school is an hour-long class where we do a more in-depth study than we do on Wednesdays. We incorporate activities, videos, memory verses, and end with an application. This month we are studying...

Grades 6-8: Youth will learn about the various sections of the Old Testament and gain a general understanding of what we find there. Next, we will look at various selections from Psalms.

Grades 9-12: We will start with our first Leadership training lesson where youth will learn about and utilize skills to plan worship sessions. Next they will learn about the books of the Old Testament and why each is important to study before moving into a study in 1 Kings.

How Permission Forms Work

Just to clarify which forms are needed for which events, here is an overview for you!

- The blue forms are annual permission forms/waivers done each fall and cover 1 school year. They give complete consent for participation in all our normal weekly events and programs
- The white forms are specific to our 3-4 yearly offsite events (corn maze, retreat, year-end trip, and if we do a mission trip). These are not as in-depth and focus more on getting permission to take a youth on that particular trip. They are shorter and simpler as they are to be done over and above the foundational/base blue forms
