Sunday March 29 Triumphal Entry Jesus as King

Memory Verse: John 14:6 Easy-to-Read Version (ERV)

⁶ Jesus answered, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. The only way to the Father is through me.

Ask the Question: Who is Jesus?

Allow kids to give different answers, review what they learned about who Jesus is in the past 3 weeks.

The Bible says Jesus is a King. Do you think he is a King? What is he a king of? How do you know?

Questions

- 1. Who was in the story? Jesus, disciples, people, Pharisees
- 2. Where was Jesus going? Jerusalem for the Passover
- 3. What did Jesus ask his disciples to do? Get a donkey
- 4. What did Jesus do with the donkey? Ride on it into Jerusalem
- 5. Why did Jesus enter Jerusalem in this way? Because the Bible had said that this is how the King of Israel would come
- 6. What did the people do when Jesus came into Jerusalem? Waved palm branches, shouted
- 7. What did the people shout? Hosanna, praise be to God, Blessings on the King
- 8. What is Jesus King of? His Kingdom, his people, all those who love him
- 9. Are there things in our world that tell us different from the Bible? Yes, some might say that Jesus was not the son of God and not a King like the Pharisees .

Answer the question – Who is Jesus?

Possible responses

Jesus as the son of God, Jesus as the Savior of the World, Jesus as King
